<p><b>Maintenance Programme</b> Person responsible for :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The maintenance of all fire safety arrangements</li> <li>• The fire warning arrangements</li> <li>• The provided fire-fighting equipment</li> <li>• High standards of house keeping</li> <li>• The control of all visitors and contractors</li> <li>• Nominating persons for calling the emergency services</li> <li>• The emergency release arrangements for the horses</li> <li>• The availability of water supplies for fire fighting</li> <li>• Ensuring a clear access for the emergency vehicles</li> </ul>	<p><b>Responsible Person</b></p>

<p><b>Emergency Action Plan</b> The person responsible for the emergency action plan, which details the procedures to be taken by <b>all</b> persons in the event of fire at the equine establishment.</p>	<p><b>Responsible Person</b></p>

<p><b>Staff Training</b> Person responsible for all the fire safety training for staff or other persons at the equine establishment.</p>	<p><b>Responsible Person</b></p>

## EXAMPLES OF IDENTIFIED FIRE HAZARDS AND RISKS

LOCATION	IDENTIFIED FIRE HAZARD OR RISK	EVALUATE IDENTIFIED PERSONS OR HORSES CONSIDERED AT SIGNIFICANT RISK	ACTIONS TO REDUCE REMOVE OR CONTROL THE HAZARD OR RISK	INFORMATION RECORDED AND REVIEW DATE
Example Tack Room	LPG Portable radiant gas heater used for drying damp blankets. Located in combustible wooden end section of stable building.	All persons using the tack room. Horse stabled in end stable next to tack room.	Remove LPG radiant gas heater from tack room. Review arrangements for drying damp blankets. Provide less hazardous types of heaters. Issue instructions to staff no to use radiant type heaters.	Action recorded in stable's fire logbook. Names of staff advised of action, Review in three month's time.
